Shelters and Gazebos

The Greenville City Park has 10 shelters ranging in capacity of 6 to 28 tables. A Gazebo is located in the City Park and Annie Oakley Park. There is a non-refundable fee to rent these facilities. For availability & reservations call 548-1314.

Church League Softball

Three different leagues are offered. Youth Coed on Tues., Adult on Thurs., & Adult Coed on Fri. All leagues play at the City Park Diamonds beginning May or June & concluding July or Aug. Informational meetings for each league will be held in April. Team participation fee is \$125. Some leagues may collect an additional fee for the cost of umpires & awards. Call 548-1314 for details.

Youth Spring Soccer

This program is for boys and girls 5 – 12 years. Soccer is held at Greenville North Park and runs from April 9 – May 19. “Meet the Team Day” is Saturday, April 9. Participants will be assigned to one team by age groups with the same coach for the entire season.

Adult coaches are needed to volunteer for this program to be successful.

5 & 6 yr. olds will play 4 v 4 (no goalies) on the small sided fields. 7 & 8 yr. olds will play 7 v 7 (plus a goalie) on the large fields. 9 – 12 yr. olds will play 8 v 8 (plus a goalie) on the large fields. Upon registration participants pay a \$15.00 fee which includes a team t-shirt. Registration deadline is April 6th. Please bring or mail registration forms to the Parks & Recreation Office.

Greenville Skate Park

The GSP is located off Harmon Dr. between the Shuffleboard Courts and the Pool entrance. The use “**At Your Own Risk**” unsupervised facility is open daily from dawn to dusk. The Skate Park will occasionally be locked up and closed during certain special events in the immediate vicinity. Rules for use are posted at the Skate Park entrance.
