

City of Greenville Parks and Recreation Department News

The Fall weather is finally upon us and many activities are moving indoors. However, the Greenville Parks are a great place to visit during the autumn months to enjoy the scenery that comes with the splendid color changes of nature. Also the various walking tracks and paths at North Park, Emette B. Smith Park, Harmon Field, and the Greenville Creek Trail are excellent Park locations to exercise during the cool fall days and evenings.

The Adult Aerobics Fall Session II Registration is currently taking place. Fall Session II will begin on November 1 and continue until December 13. Classes are on Monday and Thursday evenings at South Middle School and East Intermediate School. Participants may select to register for Tae-Bo, Pilates, and Intermediate Aerobics. Each class size is limited to the first 40 registrations and is \$12 for the entire Session. You must register and pay the fee at the Parks and Recreation Office prior to the first class.

The Youth Wrestling Program, a seasonal favorite, is currently accepting registration forms for youth ages 5-13. Registration Forms have been distributed to the Greenville City Schools and the Darke County Schools. There is an important Sign-up meeting on Saturday, November 10 at 10 AM at the First Presbyterian Church located at 114 E. 4th St. in Greenville. Practices will begin November 20 at the Greenville Senior High School. Practices are held twice a week on Tuesday evenings and Saturday mornings. Participants must purchase a U.S.A. Wrestling Card (cost is \$40) to be eligible to compete in any league meets. There will be 6 or 7 league meets beginning in January through February. There will be a meet at the Greenville Senior High School Gym on January 6 and the other meets will be at nearby communities.

The Men's Power Volleyball League will begin playing on Wednesday evenings at the Greenville Junior High School Gym beginning November 28. This program will continue until January 30. The league is limited to 7 teams with a \$100 entry fee paid upon registration.

For those who like to plan early for that special gathering next summer for a family reunion, birthday party, or just a family picnic, the Greenville City Park offers 10 Shelter Houses (ranging in size from 6 to 28 tables) that can be rented. Reservations are currently being taken for 2008 with dates already rapidly filling up. Shelter Reservations for the 2009 Season will begin on October 29, 2007.
