ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

CHEYANNE TONER of Versailles will present on backyard beekeeping. CheyAnne is an experienced bee keeper. She will explain how a bee hive operates and offer tips on how to keep a hive healthy.

JANELL WEISS of Darke SWCD will discuss organic controls for garden pests. She will present management techniques for pests covering aphids to whiteflies. Janell will draw from experience gained in her own garden and as an integrated pest management manager at an Ohio organic produce farm.

FRED WILLIAMS of the Natural Alternative will share information about compost and worm castings. Worm castings, or worm manure, is an organic fertilizer. The Natural Alternative composts leaves, limbs and horse manure. Fred uses worms to further break down that organic matter and increase the nutrient density in the compost.
